Dr. Waldron obtained his D.V.M. from the University of Missouri in 1974 and completed his internship at Angell Memorial Animal Hospital. After 3 years of private practice he completed his surgical residency at the University of Florida in 1980. Dr. Waldron served as an Instructor at the University of Florida from 1980-1982, as Assistant and Associate Professor of Surgery at Louisiana State University from 1982-1988. He moved to and taught surgery to students, interns, and residents for 21 years at Virginia Tech University from 1988-2009.

He currently is a surgeon and Director of Specialty Services at VCA Veterinary Referral center in Albuquerque, New Mexico. He is a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Surgeons.

He coauthored the textbook *Atlas of Approaches for General Surgery in the Dog and Cat*. He is currently the Soft Tissue editor for the 5th edition of *Current Techniques in Small Animal Surgery* (MJ Bojrab, editor) Dr. Waldron is a member of the editorial board for *Veterinary Forum* and enjoys his role in responding to practitioner questions in *Veterinary Forum*.
